

**PETITION FOR AN INDEPENDENT INVESTIGATION IN THE DEATH OF
GLADYS TOLLEY**

Considering that a tragic incident occurred on October 6, 2001, whereby Mrs. Gladys Tolley, Kitigan Zibi community member, died as a result of being hit by a Sureté du Québec police car on Highway 105 located within the Kitigan Zibi Anishinabeg reserve territory.

Considering that upon acquiring and reviewing various relevant documents, including police reports from the Sureté du Québec, the Kitigan Zibi Police Department and the Montreal Urban Community Police, containing the facts mentioned by several witnesses, several contradictions and anomalies were identified, indicating that the investigation and the procedures were not necessarily conducted according to accepted police procedures;

Considering that it is in the best interest of all parties and society in general to have all facts in regards to this situation clearly disclosed so as to ensure transparency and accountability;
